

New UL label requirements for lighting products



In 2021 UL is phasing out lighting holographic labels and certain other types that are currently ordered through a UL Label Center for lighting manufacturers and moving to a nonholographic label employing an enhanced Mark (approved through our UL Marks Hub) in its place.

Each UL Certification Mark indicates product attributes, service description, country code, file number, and an optional QR code that leads to a UL-hosted certification page.

- Instead of having to order lighting labels through UL, you can either print your UL Mark labels directly within your facility or purchase directly from an authorized label supplier.
- Enjoy the benefit of no annual label fee from UL through self-printing your labels, or you may purchase labels directly from a UL authorized label center.
- Visit www.UL.com/lightinglabels to confirm if your products are affected by the lighting label change and to view the timeline, which begins Jan. 1, 2021.

Whether you decide to print your own UL Mark labels at your manufacturing facility or use an authorized label supplier, our Marks Hub at <https://markshub.ul.com/> will guide you to design the appropriate UL Mark artwork. You will need to get a one-time stamped approval from our UL Label Center on your artwork.

The enhanced artwork includes an optional QR code that leads to a webpage hosted by UL that includes:

- Information about the product and certifications from UL's Product iQ™ database
- Manufacturer information, created and edited by your company
- Product information and images, uploaded and edited by your company

We encourage you to use the QR code option to give customers the most up-to-date information about your product directly from your label. Updating your information on the UL hosted webpage is easy; simply go to our Marks Hub and log in to My Certification Pages to edit or update at any time.
